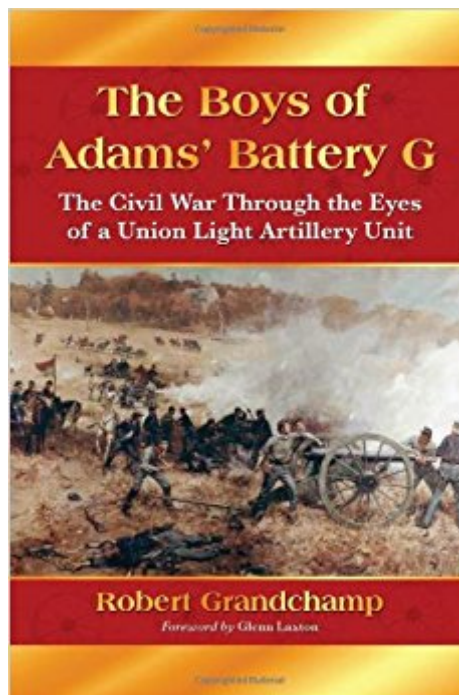

Raised from Rhode Island farmers and millworkers in the autumn of 1861, the Union soldiers of Battery G fought in such bloody conflicts as Antietam, Chancellorsville, Gettysburg, Spotsylvania, and Cedar Creek. At the storming of Petersburg on April 2, 1865, seven cannoneers were awarded the Medal of Honor for heroism in the face of the enemy. This history captures the battlefield exploits of the "Boys of Hope" but also depicts camp life, emerging cannon technology, and the social backdrop of the Civil War.

I was a bit worried about getting this book because of the price and it turning out to be a dud. This is a great buy! This covers more than just union artillery training and tactics. This covers how the AoP evolved its use of artillery and its command of artillery. How Rhode Island turned out the best cannoneers during the Civil War and how this group of young boys grew up and became some of the bravest and toughest of them. It is also very easy to understand the story Mr Grandchamp is telling. He does not stray too far from the lives of the cannoneers of battery G when he puts the context of what is happening around them in the AoP during the war. He only shows some favoritism for the generals from RI. I do think a new reader who wants to get into the Civil War readings, this should be one of their 1st books.
