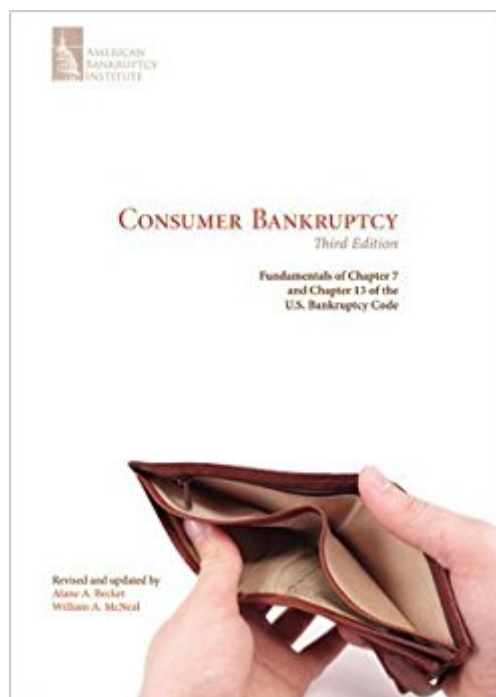




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Consumer Bankruptcy: Fundamentals Of Chapter 7 And Chapter 13 Of The U.S. Bankruptcy Code, Third Edi
