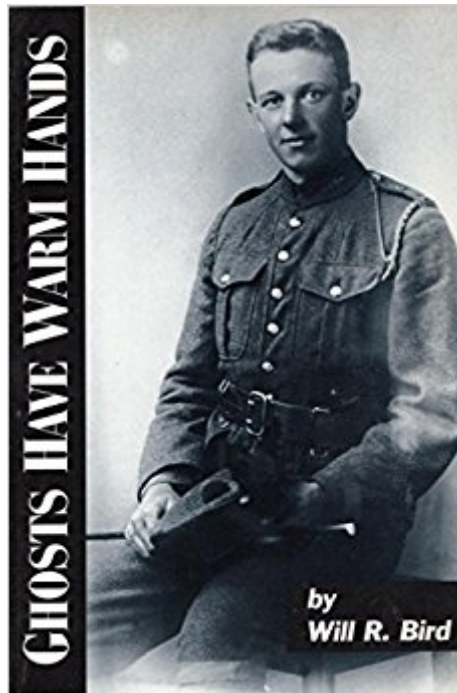

A remarkable tale of trench warfare written in exceptional detail. Throughout there are bits of humour as well as showing the horrors of combat. The camaraderie between the soldiers is strongly demonstrated as well. A book hard to put down and one is compelled to read it a second time. The author had a brother killed in the First World War and tragically his son was killed in the Second World War. This man knows what he is writing about. Another great book by this author is *No Retreating Footsteps*.

This book is spectacular. As a 4th year history major (with an emphasis on Canadian military history) I can assure anybody who is looking for details on what it was like for the CEF in the trenches, Bird captures it perfectly. Other books by CEF Books are just as worthy and deserve to be checked out.

Having an interest in military history, I have read a large number of autobiographies written by combat soldiers throughout the 20th century. This is far and away the best. In my opinion, WWI was the ugliest war during the previous century, and the trench warfare of this conflict comes to life on the pages of this book, and to a degree that I have never found in any other military biography. It is quite an old book, but completely captures the misery, agony, horror, hopelessness, and despair of the trench soldiers of this conflict in a way that still appears to contemporary readers. This should be required reading at all military academies!

This is the best book I've read about the Canadian experience of WWI. Highly, highly, highly recommended.
