

This thorough analysis of the Chilean servicesâ™ history, education, values, and worldview shows how this military culture shaped Chilean thinking and behavior, shedding light on the distinctive qualities of Chileâ™s armed forces, the militaryâ™s decision to depose Allende, and the Pinochet dictatorshipâ™s resilience, repressiveness, and durability. Â Bawdenâ™s account of Chileâ™s vast and complex military history of the twentieth century will appeal to political scientists, historians, faculty and graduate students interested in Latin America and its armed forces, students of USâ™ Latin American diplomacy, and those interested in issues of human rights.
