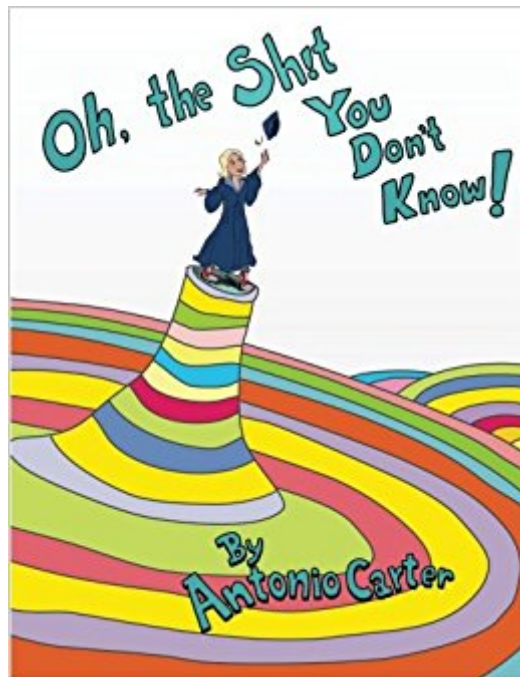




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Oh, The Sh!t You Don't Know!: College Graduate Edition
