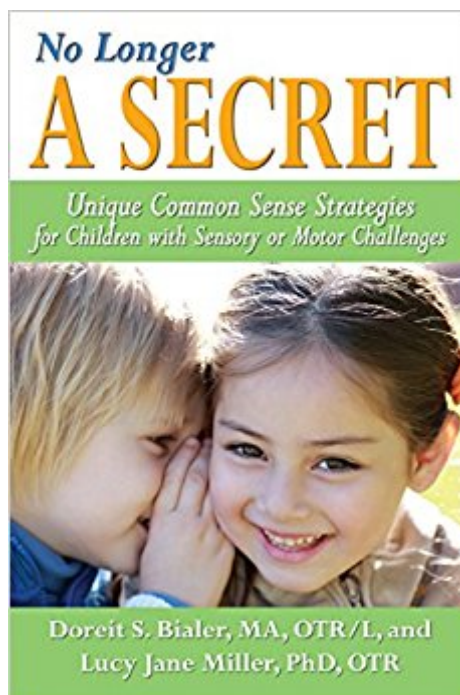

Although a bit more technical, No Longer A SECRET is written by two expert occupational therapists for an audience of parents and educators eager to help children better access the curriculum, make friends and develop self-esteem. I am going to compare the two books because although there is overlapping information, each offers readers a different perspective. Both books describes the sensory systems and subtypes of Sensory Processing Disorders (SPD)- which are as follows:* Sensory Modulation Disorder sensory over-responsivity sensory under-responsivity sensory craving* Sensory-Based Motor disorder postural disorder dyspraxia* Sensory discrimination DisorderBoth books do an excellent job of explaining red flags and symptoms of SPD and how the concepts that make up the acronym "A SECRET" are used to problem solve solutions. The elements of A SECRET are:* A- Attention* S-Sensation* E-Emotional Regulation* C- Culture,
