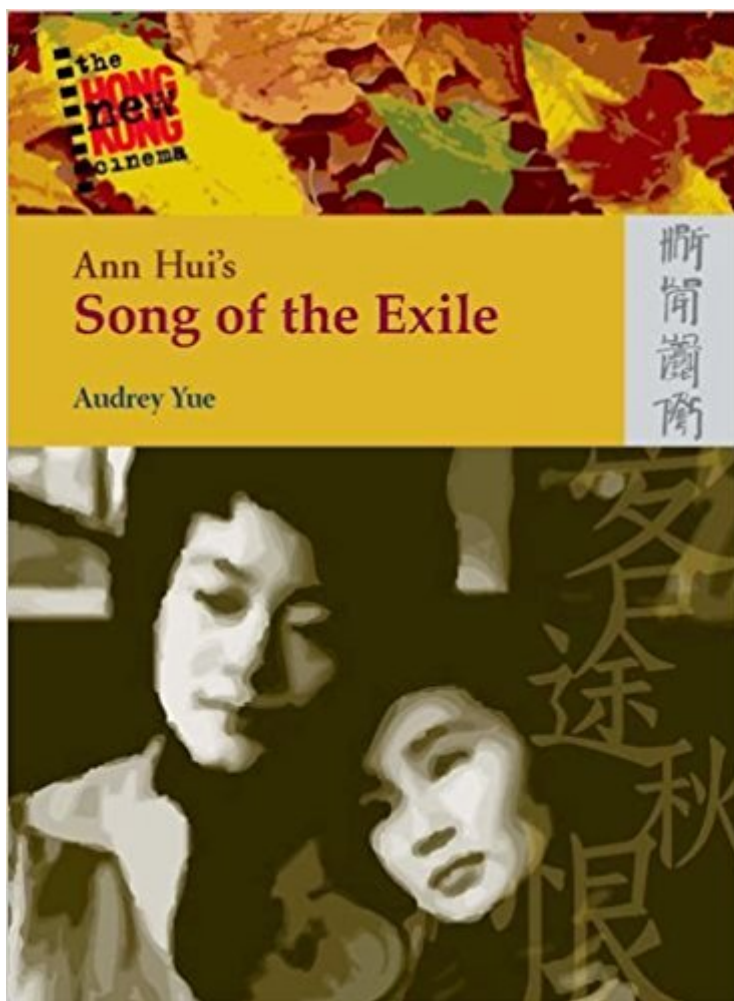


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Ann Hui's Song Of The Exile (The New Hong Kong Cinema)
