Great quick read to brush up on the type of hands that come up frequently when playing poker tournaments and the optimal ways to handle them. Quick easy read. I consider myself an intermediate player. I would recommend this to a beginner/intermediate player but not to a complete novice. I have read books by Negranu, Brunson, and Harrington. His strategy differs somewhat but I did learn a few things, specifically how to get just a little more value out of specific hands based on which type of player you're facing and the preflop action. I think all the hands were heads up vs one opponent once you got to the flop and most involve 3x pre flop raises. I didn't pay for this because I used kindle unlimited. I would probably not pay more than \$3 for this book.

This is an interesting book... Booklet actually... Still some good thoughts about flop decisions. Of course this isn't an actual, normal sized "book", but for the price it's being sold and the content, it is an easy 5 star...
